
CARE INSTRUCTIONS

For copying and printing reasons, the appearance of colours, and decors in the illustrations of panels and handles is without engagement. For an exact colour adjustment, we recommend using original RAL colour fans or adeco colour sample cards. The effect of glazings and colours also depends on different lighting conditions, time of day and time of year and the individual location.

In order to extend the life cycle of LED lightings, we recommend using them from dusk till daybreak. Especially dark entrance door colours in exposed locations with substantial sun radiation result in higher temperatures of the LEDs, reducing their durability. New LEDs can be ordered from specialist shops.

The face widths of the casement profile vary, depending on the installation situation and the profile systems used for casement and sash. The required panel width also depends on the profile system you use. The appearance of an entrance door may change since the individual dimensions of your entrance door may differ from the ones in our catalogue.
